General Agency Information & Services Offered - Description of our mission and explanation of the services we offer to our clientele and community. *(All) 20-30 min.*

Healthy Relationships - Interactive with a focus on healthy/unhealthy relationship traits in dating and friendships. How to avoid negative relationships. *(School grades 6-12) 50 min.*

Healthy Relationships – Student Athletes - Healthy relationships training with an emphasis on the unique challenges presented to a student athlete. Bring awareness to consent laws, social media etiquette, and recognition of negative relationships. Discuss leadership opportunities that participation in athletics brings. This course was designed in collaboration with ex-collegiate and NFL athletes. *(School grades 7-12; Universities) 50 min.*

Family & Teen Dating Violence 101 - Introduction to the realities of family violence and dating violence. We identify what they look like and how they affect our community through an imbalance of power and control in relationships. *(School grades 6-12) 50 min.*

Bystander Intervention - Research indicates that many sexual assaults could be prevented through the education of bystanders. We look at why bystanders fail to act and offer some strategies for intervention. *(School grades 9-12; Universities) 50 min.*

Domestic Violence & Sexual Assault Awareness – Secondary Educators - Bring awareness to the early and often overlooked signs of abuse and sexual assault in teens. Discuss red flags and apply real-world scenarios. *(Secondary teachers, coaches, school nurses) 50 min.*

Effects of Trauma & Domestic Violence Awareness – First Responders - Bring awareness of intimate partner violence issues specific to first responders. Impact of recurring trauma and its effect on those we serve. Real-world application and practicality are emphasized. *(Law enforcement; EMTs; Nurses; Other medical staff) 50 min.*

Family Violence Awareness – Senior Citizens - Inform senior citizens and their caretakers about the various forms of abuse most present among those 65 and over. How to recognize abuse and ways to protect them from being vulnerable. *(Senior citizens; Caretakers) 50 min.*

Family Violence Prevention – Faith Based Communities - Many who experience family violence turn to their religious communities for guidance. Share our expertise with those who are in positions to guide those in need of family violence related services. Emphasize how our services may be of use. *(Priests/Clergy; Deacons/Elders; Faith based instructors and staff) 50 min.*
